Notice is hereby given that on the _____ day of _____, 20__ Letters Testamentary/Administration in respect to the estate of _____ who died _____ were issued to the undersigned by the Chancery Court of Sullivan County, Tennessee. All persons, resident and non-resident, having claims, matured or unmatured, against the estate are required to file the same with the Clerk & Master of the above named Court on or before the earlier of the dates prescribed in (1) or (2) otherwise their claims will be forever barred:

(1) (A) Four (4) months from the date of the first publication (or posting, as the case may be) of this **Notice** if the creditor received an actual copy of this **Notice to Creditors** at least sixty (60) days before the date that is four (4) months from the date of the first publication (or posting); or

(B) Sixty (60) days from the date the creditor received an actual copy of the **Notice to Creditors** if the creditor received the copy of the **Notice** less than sixty (60) days prior to the date that is four (4) months from the date of first publication (or posting) as described in (1)(A); or

(2) Twelve (12) months from the decedent's date of death.
