AND NOW, this _____ of _____, 20____, upon consideration of the Petition for Appointment of Emergency Guardian ("Petition") filed by _____, Esquire, as counsel for _____ and following a: ____ conference/ ____ hearing held on: _____, 20____, it appearing to the Court that _____ (Respondent) appears to lack capacity, is in need of a guardian, and failure to make such appointment will result in irreparable harm to the following: _____ Person of the Respondent, _____ Estate of Respondent, the Petition is **GRANTED** and pursuant to 20 Pa.C.S. § 5513, _____ are is/are appointed as emergency guardian(s) of the: _____ Person (only), _____ Estate (only) _____ Person and Estate of Respondent.

FURTHERMORE, all financial institutions, including without limitation, banks, savings and loans, credit unions, and brokerages, shall grant to the Guardian(s) of _____ [Respondent's] estate access to any and all assets, records, and accounts maintained for the benefit of Respondent, and the Guardian(s) of Respondent's estate shall be entitled to transfer, retitle, withdraw, or to otherwise exercise dominion and control over any and all said assets, records and accounts. The failure of any financial institution to honor this order may lead to contempt proceedings and the imposition of sanctions.

This Order shall expire in 72 hours (3 days) from the date of this order for guardianship of Respondent's person and 30 days from the date of this order for guardianship of the estate, unless extended by separate order.
